A PASTOR'S LIFE & HOUSE CHURCH

In July of last year at the height of the pandemic and isolation fatigue, the Lord strongly impressed upon Jesus the call to begin church gatherings within our home. With respect to the risks of Covid-19, we began gathering on Sundays for in-person potluck lunch, prayer, study and worship. In December of 2020 Jesus was officially ordained as a pastor and our gatherings have grown to 3x a week, as well as Friday men's bible study and daily one-on-one discipleship with those whom the Lord has entrusted us to shepherd. The results of our obedience to God's call has been incredible. Praise God that 28 people have been baptized and are continuing discipleship! May His awesome works of reconciliation & redemption continue to multiply!
